**Principal Recommendation Scheme**  
**for AHKCMS Member Schools in 2026/2027**

1. Tung Wah College (TWC) is currently receiving direct applications for the following programmes\*:

- Bachelor of Education (Honours) in Early Childhood Education (Self-financing)
- Bachelor of Management (Honours) in Social and Business Sustainability (Self-financing)
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Biomedical Science (Self-financing)
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Forensic Biomedical Science (Self-financing)
- Bachelor of Social Science (Honours) in Applied Psychology (Self-financing)
- Higher Diploma in Early Childhood Education (Self-financing)
- Higher Diploma in Health Science (SSSDP)
- Higher Diploma in Nursing (SSSDP)
- Higher Diploma in Psychology (Self-financing)

2. To be eligible for the Principal Recommendation Scheme (“PRS”), recommended candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Be senior secondary 6 students in the academic year during which applications are submitted;
- Be sitting public examinations for graduating senior secondary school leavers in 2026, i.e. HKDSE.

3. The PRS includes the following two distinct pathways for candidates:

3.1 Academic Pathway

This pathway recognises and rewards students who demonstrate strong academic performance and potential.

Selection Criteria:

Candidates have to demonstrate strong academic performance and potential to succeed in their selected programme. Evidence of their ability to thrive in an academic environment should be provided through school reports, academic records, awards, or other relevant academic achievements.

### 3.2 Non-Academic Pathway

This pathway is designed for recommended students who may not fully meet the standard academic entry requirements but have demonstrated outstanding non-academic achievements.

Selection Criteria:

Candidates must have notable accomplishments in areas such as sports, arts, leadership, community service, or other extracurricular activities that highlight their unique talents and contributions.

4. The application procedure of the PRS is as follows:

- Each AHKCMS member school may submit **a maximum of FOUR recommendations** via academic or non-academic pathway.
- There is a **GUARANTEED interview opportunity** for recommended students which will take place in June tentatively.
- Successful candidates will receive **ONE unconditional offer**<sup>^</sup># as deemed appropriate.
- Recommended candidates must **complete the full application procedures** by submitting their applications online at <https://www.twc.edu.hk/admission/>.
- **Application fee is NOT required** for recommended students. Their application will be proceeded after the recommendation is verified.

<sup>^</sup> For the Higher Diploma in Nursing (SSSDP), only a conditional offer will be made to successful PRS candidates. These candidates must meet the minimum entrance requirements set by the NCHK, i.e. achieving HKDSE results of “222A2” for this programme.

# Recommended candidates who pass the interview but do not fully meet the minimum entrance requirements will be admitted under the non-standard entry quota, enabling the College to admit students with exceptional potential beyond academic metrics.

5. AHKCMS member schools are requested to submit their “Principal’s Recommendation” list using the attached recommendation form and reach TWC **on or before Friday, 5 June 2026**.
